Parade Route: The dog parade will begin at Louisiana Avenue at Indiana Avenue, proceed north on Louisiana Ave to Hood Park/Front Street where it will disband. Dog parade route is a total of 3 blocks long.

Assembly/Mandatory Check-In: Commodore Schoolyard at 9:30 am. Judging will be at 9:45. Parade begins at 10.

Registration: Registrations will be accepted until the maximum number is received or until the registration cutoff date of August 25, 2017, whichever comes first.

Dog Parade Terms and Conditions

- Dogs only! No other types of animals will be allowed to enter.
- Registration is limited to 25 entries in each category.
- One prize will be awarded for each weight category. Entries will be judged on costumes. Prizes will be awarded after the parade.
- All entries must be individually registered prior to the parade date. The organizer is not responsible for late or lost entries.
- Dog handlers must be 18 years old and must check in on the day of the parade.
- Any children under the age of 18 accompanying an entry must have a parent walk with them.
- No more than 1 dog per handler.
- Dogs must be vaccinated for rabies, leptospirosis & distemper and treated for fleas at least 3 weeks prior to the event.
- No aggressive animals or females that are in season are allowed to participate.
- Dogs must be on a leash less than 6 feet long at all times. No retractable leashes.
- Dogs and owners must be in costume.
- Dogs may not be left unattended at any time.
- Dogs wearing shock collars are not permitted.
- The dog's behavior is the responsibility of the handler and owner. Dogs must be under control at all times. Participants/dogs will be required to leave if dog shows any signs of aggression or disruptive behavior toward people or other animals.
- Handlers are required to clean up after their dogs with pet waste bags and dispose of waste properly.
- Owners are responsible for any damage done by their dogs at the event.
- At the discretion of the organizer, handlers and their dogs may be asked, for any reason, to leave the event.
- If a dog is stressed or overwhelmed during the parade, handlers should move off to the side for a moment and take a break.
- If a dog is nervous in large crowds or uncomfortable with loud noises, please consider leaving him/her at home.
- Use good judgement on all matters concerning the dogs!
- Handlers should wear sensible shoes in order to handle the dog in a safe manner.
- Judging will take place before the parade steps off. Judge's decisions will be final.
- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the parade. Prizes are to be received as offered and are not redeemable for cash.
- The organizer shall not be liable for any loss or damage or for any injury suffered by an owner, handler, any other parade participant, or pet involved in the parade.
